

Greely Guidance Model

The Greely High School Guidance model focuses on the educational, personal and career development of all students. Within the framework of these developmental goals, the guidance counselors support each student in developing and working toward achieving their goals.

There are three guidance counselors at Greely High School. Two out of the three guidance counselors focus primarily on the freshmen, sophomores, and juniors. These students are assigned a guidance counselor based on the first letter of their last name (A-L and M-Z). The third guidance counselor is a senior counselor who primarily focuses on the college planning process and post secondary plans of seniors.

Students meet with their guidance counselors many times throughout their high school career. **As freshman**, students meet their counselor to help pick and plan an academic schedule. **As sophomores**, students participate in a career preparation course taught by guidance. This course explores the student's interests and skills, as well as engages them in career research and a job shadowing experience. **As juniors**, they are encouraged to meet with their guidance counselor for a junior interview in the fall to develop and hone their college planning or other post-secondary plans and prepare to transfer to the senior counselor in the spring.. **As seniors**, they will schedule a fall meeting; which is referred to as the student's senior interview during this meeting seniors will focus on their post-secondary plans. The senior interview is also utilized for gathering information for senior counselor to write the student's recommendation.
